

**RESOLUTION

**A RESOLUTION FOR PAYMENT OF COST ASSOCIATED WITH PARADES AND SEPCIAL
EVENTS WITHIN THE CITY OF SELMA**

WHEREAS, special events, festivals, parades and other such organized events enhance the quality of life for residents and visitors alike and further helps sustain and promote our tourist economy within the City of Selma; *and*

WHEREAS, the intent of this resolution is to insure that the city has adequate advance notice of a proposed special event or parade, with the cooperation of the organizers, in order to properly plan the city services, such as security, sanitation, traffic control and other services that may be required for such events; *and*

WHEREAS, the Selma City Council further desires to establish a process for payment and/or reimbursement of costs associated with the consumption or use of said public resources as a result of the congregation of people and/or the planned event in the City of Selma; *and*

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELMA, ALABAMA, as follows:

1. "Parade" shall mean any march, race, procession or assembly of persons which may include animals, vehicles, or any combination thereof which is to assemble or travel in unison upon any street or sidewalk of the City which does not comply with normal or usual traffic regulations or controls.
2. "Special Event" shall mean any preplanned single gathering, event or series of related consecutive daily gatherings or events expected to draw citizens, visitors, participants or spectators being proposed to be held on public property within the City of Selma.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any organizer/applicant of a parade or special event in the City of Selma requiring the expenditure of public resources as determined by the City of Selma, including, but not limited to police, fire, security, sanitation and traffic control shall be required to make payment to the City for such costs of services as determined by the City prior to the granting of said permit for such event.


