Authorization to enter into agreement with

GOODWYN, MILLS AND CAWOOD, INC.

CE&I Services as it relates to the Riverfront Amphitheatre Project

WHEREAS, the CITY OF SELMA is the recipient of a 2010 Community Development Block Grant Number LR-CE- PF-10-014 from the State of Alabama for the construction of an amphitheater in the City of Selma; *and*

WHEREAS, the City did advertise for Request for Proposals for CE&I services in the Selma Times-Journal on November 26 2010 and December 3, 2010; Mobile Register and Montgomery Advertiser on November 30, 2010 and has determined that the Proposal submitted by Goodwyn, Mills and Cawood is the most acceptable; *and*

WHEREAS, the City has complied fully with the procurement requirements as set forth in O.M.B. Circular A-102 Attachment O, and the Common Rule as adopted by the State of Alabama, *and*

WHEREAS, George P. Evans in his capacity as Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Goodwyn, Mills and Cawood, Inc. in the amount of \$31,274.00 and preliminary geotechnical investigation of \$3,500.00 and material testing of \$4,000.00.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama that:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the incurred expenses of the agreement are obligated in the 2010 Community Development Block Grant.


